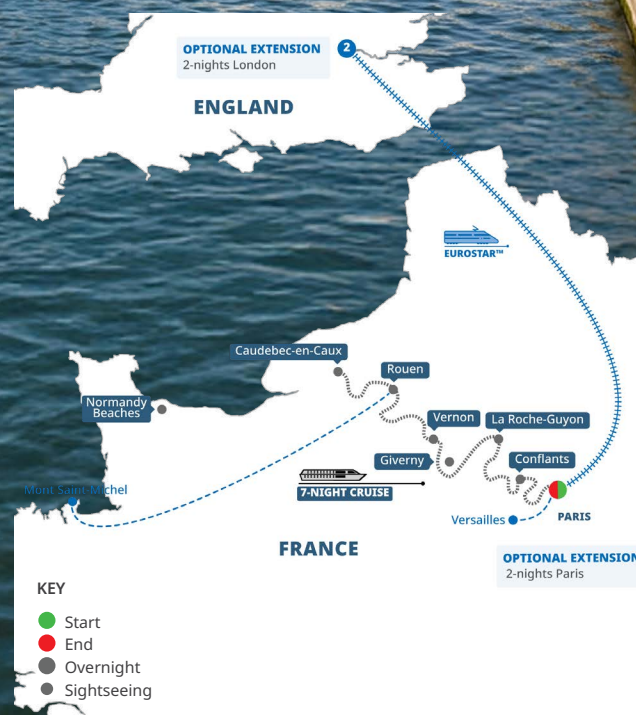

Best of the Seine with Paris and Normandy

Day 1 | Welcome to Paris

Arrive in glittering Paris to transfer to your ship, your home on the River Seine. Join your fellow travelers for dinner and share a toast to the journey ahead as your Paris river cruise gets underway. **(D)**

Day 2 | Monet's Gardens in Giverny

Immerse in Claude Monet's house and the gardens that inspired his work. Continue to Château Gaillard, Richard the Lionheart's cliff-top fortress, then walk to Les Andelys for an orientation with your Experience Director. Stroll riverside lanes, stop for coffee or a pastry, or simply absorb the idyllic atmosphere before returning to the ship for dinner. **(B,L,D)**

Day 3 | Exploring Normandy's wartime history

Take a moment for quiet reflection as you stand on the shores where history turned in WWII. Explore sites where Allied forces came ashore in 1944 at Utah and Omaha beaches, or follow the Commonwealth route at the Juno Beach Centre and Arromanches Museum, with Canadian landings, British evacuations and ANZAC contributions. **(B,D)**

Day 4 | Cruise through Normandy to Rouen

Today, choose to explore the architecture and history of Rouen's old town with your Experience Director or an Optional Experience full-day visit to striking island abbey of Mont-Saint-Michel. Explore independently in the afternoon or join an Optional Experience of a tasting tour of Normandy. Tonight, an evening on ship for dinner and live entertainment. **(B,L,D)**

Day 5 | Cider and Sights in La Roche-Guyon

Arrive in the village of La Roche-Guyon with its medieval tower and rock carved fortress lookout of Château de La Roche-Guyon. You can choose a morning guided trail hike and meet the group in the village, to then head to a nearby cider farm for your Be My Guest experience for lunch. Tour the orchard, learn traditional cider making and enjoy a seasonal meal. **(B,BMG L,D)**

Be My Guest

See firsthand why Normandy is known as "the orchard of France". Visit a family-run cider house and tour the orchards, learning how traditional methods turn hundreds of local apple varieties into fizzy, fermented cider. Then sit down to a relaxed, home-cooked meal made with seasonal ingredients grown on the farm.

Day 6 | Van Gogh's Seine to Paris

Today you have two options: You can visit Château de Malmaison, once home to Joséphine Bonaparte, and explore rooms filled with Empire-style furnishings and Napoleonic period artifacts. Or join an artist's walk through the village that was Van Gogh's home and final resting place. Return to the ship for lunch before an afternoon of sailing. **(B,L,D)**

Day 7 | Explore Paris' Delights

Welcome back to the city of lights and a multitude of options to choose from. You join an Optional Experience to the Palace of Versailles, a panoramic Paris orientation tour with your Experience Director, or a MAKE TRAVEL MATTER® Experience focused on the city's ongoing transformation through sustainable urban planning. This afternoon, explore at your own pace or join an Optional Experience foodie walk through local markets and neighborhoods. Tonight, take your pick of Paris after dark with Optional Experiences including dinner in Montmartre or a classic Parisian cabaret show. **(B,L,D)**
