Armenian American Alumni Chapter Book Scholarship (\$1,000)

- **Eligibility:** Students must demonstrate a consistent commitment to the benefit and advancement of the Armenian community on and/or off campus.
- **Short Answer Prompt:** How do you support the Armenian community? Share examples of how your service and activities you have participated in support and promote the Armenian community, culture, education and history.

Black Alumni Chapter Book Scholarship (\$1,500)

- **Eligibility:** Students shall demonstrate an interest in the Black/African-American community through active participation in activities, clubs and/or organizations that promote an agenda of justice for, unity amongst, equality for and/or advancement of Black/African-American people.
- **Short Answer Prompt:** Please describe how your volunteer and/or extra-curricular activities contribute to the betterment of or advancement of the Black/African-American community, providing details of your role and the number of hours per month given to this cause.

Engineering Alumni Society Chapter Book Scholarship (\$500)

- **Eligibility:** Students must be pursuing one or more engineering degrees.
- **Short Answer Prompt:** Express how you intend to leverage your engineering degree to drive future innovations.

Filipino American Alumni Chapter Book Scholarship (\$1,000)

- **Eligibility:** Students must demonstrate a consistent commitment to the Filipino American (Fil-Am) community through on- and/or off-campus involvement. Involvement is defined as, but not limited to: working with, membership in, participation in, or holding a leadership position in Fil-Am organizations.
- **Short Answer Prompt:** Share an issue that has affected the Fil-Am community. How have you addressed this issue and/or how do you hope to address this issue in the future?

Information & Computer Science Alumni Chapter Book Scholarship (\$1,000)

- **Eligibility:** Students should demonstrate a passion for using technology to address real-world problems, have interest in leveraging computer science skills to innovate and solve practical problems and show a commitment to applying technology for social good.
- **Short Answer Prompt:** Share your involvement in fostering innovation and creativity within the tech community. Highlight initiatives you've led or participated in that have sparked new ideas, encouraged experimentation, or facilitated interdisciplinary collaboration. How have these initiatives enhanced the tech community?

Iranian American Alumni Chapter Book Scholarship (\$750)

- **Eligibility:** Students must demonstrate a consistent commitment to the benefit and advancement of the Iranian American community on and/or off campus.
- **Short Answer Prompt:** Please show how your volunteer and/or extra-curricular activities contribute to the betterment of the first-generation immigrant community. How do you support this community and share examples of how you enrich it today.

Korean American Alumni Chapter Book Scholarship (\$1,000)

- **Eligibility:** Students must express an interest in the Korean American culture and community.
- **Short Answer Prompt:** How do you support the Korean American community? Share examples of how your activities enrich this community today.

Latino Alumni Chapter Book Scholarship (\$1,000)

- **Eligibility:** Students should demonstrate a meaningful commitment to the benefit and advancement of the Latinx community.
- **Short Answer Prompt:** Please share how your experiences have shaped you and pushed you to support the Latinx community.

Law Enforcement Officer (LEO) Alumni Chapter Book Scholarship (\$500)

- **Eligibility:** Students interested in law enforcement or related field careers through coursework, internship, volunteering, employment or other means.
- **Short Answer Prompt:** Please describe 1) how your education, volunteer, and/or extra-curricular activities inspire your interest in a career in law enforcement or related field and 2) how do you imagine yourself contributing to these fields.

Orange County Alumni Chapter Book Scholarship (\$500)
